

## Penobscot Nation Guide Application

As allowed for under Chapter VII Inland Fish and Game Regulations, the Director of the Department of Natural Resources shall issue guide permits to applicants who he is satisfied are "qualified and competent." In order to determine in applicants meet this criteria, a standard test will be given which questions the applicant on the following areas:

1. Applicable laws, ordinances and regulations,
2. Knowledge of the Penobscot Nation territories they will be guiding in, including familiarity with roads, boundaries, streams, lakes and other obvious landmarks,
3. Knowledge of First Aid procedures, with some type of formal training or certification preferred.
