## <u>APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR A DESIGNATED HUNTER</u>

- 1. This procedure governs the application process for tribal members to become a designated hunter in accordance with the "Sustenance" section of Chapter VII, Fish and Game Regulations of the Penobscot Nation.
- 2. Tribal members wishing to become a designated hunter must file an application at the DNR office.
- 3. DNR will forward all designated hunter applications to the Fish and Game Committee for review/action at the <u>next scheduled</u> meeting of the committee. <u>Applications will not be approved/denied between meetings unless a regularly scheduled meeting is cancelled.</u>
- 4. Upon review and approval of an application, the Fish and Game Committee will forward the application to DNR for issuance of the permit.
